

## **HOW TO APPLY FOR A LEARNERS LICENCE**

A Learners License is the first step in ensuring your future as a competent drivers, as all things in life we need to crawl before we can walk. After obtaining a Learners License you will be able to practice the driving skills, techniques and manoeuvres to ensure moving to the next level, the Drivers License

A learner's licence test can be done at any DLTC in South Africa, but it is best to write it in the province the person lives.

A person is forbidden by law to drive any vehicle without the appropriate learner's licence if the person doesn't have a driver's licence yet.

The following learner's licence codes can be applied for :

- Code 1: Motorcycle without a sidecar, motor tricycle or motor quadrucycle with engine of any capacity. (Please note that for a motor cycle / tricycle or quadrucycle with cc more than 125 cc the applicant needs to be 18 years of age or older).
- Code 2: Any motor vehicle except code 1 with a tare less than 3500kg or minibus, bus, goods delivery vehicle of which the gross mass does not exceed 3500kg or a tractor.
- Code 3: Any motor vehicle except code 1 or 2 (applicant needs to be 118 years of age or older)

To book an appointment the applicant will need the following :

- Complete the LL1 form ([link to pdf](#)) and take it with to the DLTC (form can also be completed at the DLTC)
- 4 black and white passport photos
- An applicant will need acceptable identification – a green bar-coded ID, or a valid temporary ID, or a valid RSA green bar-coded passport – as well as a copy thereof.
- An eye test will be done at the DLTC, so the applicant must please make sure to take with prescription spectacles if applicable.
- Appropriate legislation fees (to be obtained from the DLTC or contact A-Plus Driving School for the current fees)
- The applicant's finger prints will be taken and once everything is completed, a receipt will be issued by the cashier when the applicant makes the payment
- Please keep this receipt as proof of payment, will be needed when the applicant goes for the actual test
- Once the applicant has a test date, the applicant can contact A-plus Driving School for a learner's course. ([link to services tab learners licence](#))
- On the day of the test the applicant must make sure that he/she take with the following :
  - Acceptable identification – a green bar-coded ID, or a valid temporary ID, or a valid RSA green bar-coded passport
  - Receipt for the appointment
  - Appropriate legislation fees (to be obtained from the DLTC or contact A-Plus Driving School for the current fees)
